

The following breakdown shows how your grade will be calculated (taken from syllabus).

Attendance	10% of total
Homework and Individual Assignments	20% of total
Group Assignments	20% of total
Average of Three Exam Grades	50% of total

So, to estimate your grade at any point, we take a weighted average of the four categories, attendance, homework and individual assignments, group assignments, and exams. Follow the steps below to find your current grade.

1. Estimate your attendance percentage: (Number of days you came to class divided by total number of class periods so far, and multiply by 100)
2. Estimate your homework and individual assignments score: (Average all the scores, divide by 10, and multiply by 100)
3. Estimate your group assignments score: (Average all the scores, divide by 10, and multiply by 100)
4. Estimate your exams score: (Average all the scores in percentage form)

Your above estimates should be in percentage form, so they should look like 85%, not .85.

5. Your current grade is equal to
- .1 x (attendance percentage)
 - + .2 x (homework and individual assignments score)
 - + .2 x (group assignments score)
 - + .5 x (exam score)
