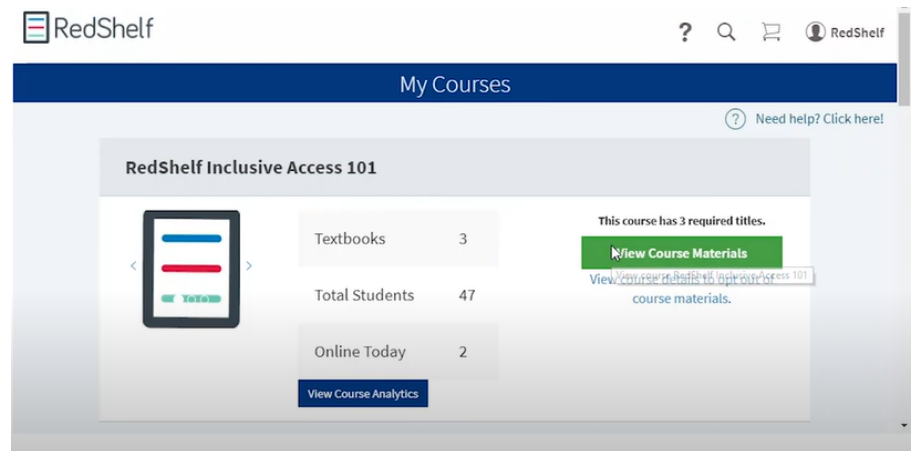


## Student Experience Publisher Courseware and eTextbook:

### Steps

1. Student signs into their LMS to access their course(s).
2. Student navigates to the RedShelf dashboard link, the name of this link will vary depending on your institutions settings (Course Materials, RedShelf, Bookshelf, etc).
3. Select View Course Materials on the courseware followed by Reveal Access Code.



4. Once a student's Access Code has been retrieved, they will navigate to the Pearson MyLab or Mastering tab in Blackboard. Naming this something like MyLab or Mastering or Pearson Homework can make this easier to locate.
5. Clicking on any of the Pearson links will prompt students into the registration process. Students who have NOT used Pearson with Blackboard before will be prompted to accept the end user license agreement and create or log into a Pearson account.
